o 3167 hands only CPR trainings conducted.

Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) Report:

Cliff Buxton: Trained almost 1,500 people since program began.

Stop the Bleed class and Dementia ID class.

Trying out new technology – software that allows transferring of documents over radio wave.

Access and Functional Needs Report:

 Autism ID first responder overview training. RCF training coming up on March. Had a request from Sonoma County to do evacuation training in August, and then second request – scheduled for October 30th but got rescheduled due to fires. Video from years ago still getting response.

7. Administrative Item New Item:

Overview of approach and communication methods for addressing PSPS. Interesting take away was that fire dispatch center barely had increase in calls for service – which we believe shows that public got message and communication was effective – was a great training exercise. Being in the WEB EOC was a great addition. County OES did amazing job – CKA please pass this on from SRV Citizen Corps. Can't remember busier day than that Sunday. SRV only part of County that didn't have a significant event.
