San Ramon Public Safety Building Construction Project to Lowest Responsive

Bidder, Roebbelen Contracting, Inc.

Background:

The Request for Proposals (RFP) for the Public Safety Building project was publicly noticed on the District and City of San Ramon websites on February 26, 2021. Information on the project was also provided to the Bay Area Builders Exchange and Bluebook.com, which serve Contra Costa County and Alameda County; this is an online plan room that maintains public works projects for their membership.

A Mandatory Pre-Bid Conference and Site Visit was held at 2401 Crow Canyon Road in San Ramon on March 2, 2021. Eleven (11) general contractors attended the meeting. On March 25, 2021, the District received five responses to the RFP; one of which was received three minutes after the 2:00 PM cutoff and was not considered. (As it turns out, the late bid would have been highest cost bid received.) The following Proposers were deemed to have submitted responsive bids;

Roebbelen Contracting, Inc. (Eldorado Hills, CA)	\$22,141,000
DL Falk Construction, Inc. (Hayward, CA)	\$22,284,000
Arntz Builders, Inc. (Petaluma, CA)	\$22,874,833
Alten Construction, Inc. (Richmond, CA)	\$23,097,000

Based on the RFP selection criteria, evaluation and feedback from references, staff is recommending the Board award the Public Safety Building construction contract to the lowest, responsive bidder, Roebbelen Contracting, Inc. In staff's opinion the Roebbelen proposal offers the best value to the District overall and is well within the budget established for the project.

The District will be utilizing the law firm of Meyers Nave to assist with finalizing the construction contract with Roebbelen, a draft of which accompanies this staff report.

Recommended Board Action:

Staff recommends award of the construction contract for the Public Safety Building project to Roebbelen Contracting, Inc., consistent with their bid and the provisions contained in the RFP;

and that the Board authorize the Fire Chief to execute a final contract with Roebbelen Contracting, Inc., in substantial form as the draft contract attached to this staff report.

Financial Impacts:

The low bid is within the budget established for this project; no additional budget appropriation is required at this time.

	3.01	Commencement of the Work. Contractor shall commence Work on the date stated in the Notice to Proceed (the "Commencement Date"). Owner reserves the right to modify or alter the Commencement Date.		
	3.02	Completion of the Work . The Work shall be performed in two phases. Contractor shall achieve Final Completion of Phase 1 within 180 Calendar Days from the date when the Contract Time commences to run. Contractor shall achieve Final Completion of Phase 2 within 450 Calendar Days from the date when the Contract Time commences to run. Contractor shall allow 14 calendar days from the completion of Phase 1 for Owner move into the completed Phase 1 before Phase 2 commences.		
4.	PROJECT REPRESENTATIVES			
	4.01	Owner's Project Manager. Owner has designated as its Project Manager to act as Owner's Representative in all matters relating to the Contract Documents. Owner's Project Manager shall have final authority over all matters pertaining to the Contract Documents and shall have sole authority to modify the Contract Documents on behalf of Owner, to accept work, and to make decisions or actions binding on Owner, and shall have sole signature authority on behalf of Owner. Owner may assign all or part of the Project Manager's rights, responsibilities and duties to a Construction Manager, or other Owner Representative.		
	4.02	Contractor's Project Manager. Contractor has designated as its Project Manager to act as Contractor's Representative in all matters relating to the Contract Documents.		

LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

- 5.01 Liquidated Damages For Delay to Substantial Completion of either Phase 1 or Phase 2. As liquidated damages for delay, Contractor shall pay Owner three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) for each Calendar Day that expires after the time specified herein for Contractor to achieve Substantial Completion of Phase 1 or Phase 2 of the Work, until achieved.
- **5.02** Liquidated Damages for Delay to Final Completion of either Phase 1 or Phase 2. As liquidated damages for delay, Contractor shall pay Owner one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) for each Day that expires after the time specified herein for Contractor to achieve Final Completion of Phase 1 or Phase 2 of the entire Work, until achieved.
- **5.03 Scope of Liquidated Damages**. The liquidated damages amounts stated in Section 5.01 and 5.02 shall apply cumulatively. Limitations and stipulations regarding liquidated damages (if any) are set forth in Document 00 7200 (General Conditions).

7. MISCELLANEOUS

- **7.01** Terms and abbreviations used in this Agreement are defined in Document 00 7200 (General Conditions) and Section 01 4200 (References and Definitions) and will have the meaning indicated therein.
- **7.02** It is understood and agreed that in no instance are the persons signing this Agreement for or on behalf of Owner or acting as an employee, agent, or representative of Owner,

liable on this Agreement or any of the Contract Documents, or upon any warranty of authority, or otherwise, and it is further understood and agreed that liability of Owner is limited and confined to such liability as authorized or imposed by the Contract Documents or applicable law.

- 7.03 In entering into a public works contract or a subcontract to supply goods, services or materials pursuant to a public works contract, Contractor or Subcontractor offers and agrees to assign to the awarding body all rights, title and interest in and to all causes of action it may have under Section 4 of the Clayton Act (15 U.S.C. §15) or under the Cartwright Act (Chapter 2 (commencing with §16700) of Part 2 of Division 7 of the Business and Professions Code), arising from purchases of goods, services or materials pursuant to the public works contract or the subcontract. This assignment shall be made and become effective at the time Owner tenders final payment to Contractor, without further acknowledgment by the parties.
- 7.04 Copies of the general prevailing rates of per diem wages for each craft, classification, or type of worker needed to execute the Contract, as determined by Director of the State of California Department of Industrial Relations, are deemed included in the Contract Documents and on file at Owner's Office, and shall be made available to any interested party on request. Pursuant to California Labor Code §§ 1860 and 1861, in accordance with the provisions of Section 3700 of the Labor Code, every contractor will be required to secure the payment of compensation to his employees. Contractor represents that it is aware of the provisions of Section 3700 of the Labor Code which require every employer to be insured against liability for workers' compensation or to undertake self-insurance in accordance with the provisions of that Code, and Contractor shall comply with such provisions before commencing the performance of the Work of the Contract Documents.
- 7.05 During the term of this Agreement, Contractor warrants that it is currently registered with the Department of Industrial Relations and qualified to perform public work consistent with Labor Code section 1725.5. Contractor further warrants that any subcontractors who are subject to Public Contract code section 4104, are registered and qualified to perform public work consistent with Labor Code section 1725.5.
- **7.06** This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.
- 7.07 This Agreement and the Contract Documents shall be deemed to have been entered into in the County of Contra Costa, State of California, and governed in all respects by California law (excluding choice of law rules). The exclusive venue for all disputes or litigation hereunder shall be in the Superior Court for the County of Contra Costa.
