Board Members Present: Directors Campbell, Dakin, Kerr and Stamey. Director Parker arrived at 2:17 p.m.

<u>Staff Present:</u> Fire Chief Meyer, Financial Consultant Campo, Fire Marshal Kiefer, Deputy Chief Phares, Deputy Chief Krause, Controller Koran, Technology Systems Manager Call, HR Consultant Steve Harman and District Clerk Maxwell.

1. Call to Order

President Kerr called the meeting to order at 2:02 p.m.

2. Pledge of Allegiance

President Kerr led the Pledge of Allegiance.

3. Determination of Quorum and Confirmation of Agenda

There was a quorum and one matter was added to Closed Session by District Counsel William Ross; Item 12.2.

4. Public Comment

*Occurred at approximately 3:40 p.m., by citizen Ross Smith of Danville. Mr. Smith relayed that he appreciated the afternoon Board meeting; in lieu of the standard evening meetings. He is a Geologist and concerned about earthquakes. He requested that the District look into a Seismic Warning System and explained his reasoning behind that request. Chief Meyer responded stating that a Seismic Warning System was already in the budget for the next fiscal year. Mr. Smith also relayed his concerns about the District's CERT program.

5. Consent Calendar

Director Stamey motioned to approve Consent Calendar items 5.1-5.6. Director Campbell seconded the motion. Director Parker was not present for vote. Motion carried with four votes.

6. Special Announcements/Presentations/General Business

Director Dakin confirmed that the Wednesday, June 3, 2015 date works with his schedule for the Budget Workshop. Location and time to be determined.

8. New Business

8.1 Mid-Year Budget Presentation, Financial Consultant Campo.

Chief Meyer introduced the presentation by thanking all contributing staff for their 2-year effort on this project. FC Campo provided the mid-year budget presentation and updated the Board about the Long-Term Forecast.

Citizen Ross Smith inquired about the Proposition 8 Recapture monies and was responded to by Chief Meyer and staff.

FC Campo made the following Mid-Year Budget Requests:

- Increase the General Fund revenue by \$2,427,000: property tax +\$2,519,000, ambulance transports -\$214,000, State reimbursements +\$255,000 and cell tower revenue -\$133,000.
- Increase the General Fund expenditures for salaries and benefits by a net \$567,000: overtime +\$894,000, pension contribution -\$467,000 and employee insurance +\$140,000.
- Increase Capital Project Fund revenue by \$5,739,000: +\$739,000 sale of Hemme property and +\$5,000,000 debt proceeds.
- Increase Debt Service Fund revenue by \$8,136,000 of debt proceeds.
- Increase Debt Service Fund expenditures by \$8,736,000: +\$177,000 for debt issuance costs and +\$8,559,000 to refund the 2006 COP debt obligation.

President Kerr made a motion to accept FC Campo's report, recommendation and requests. Ayes: Stamey, Parker, Dakin and Campbell. Noes: None

9. Correspondence

One letter, briefly reviewed Board members.

10. Monthly Activity Reports

10.1 Operations Division-Deputy Chief Phares

Operations Report of monthly activities.

In addition to the submission of his report, Deputy Chief Phares expounded on the EOC trainings attended by staff, other jurisdictions and local law enforcement. He relayed that Battalion Chiefs Taylor and Spani taught the Driver Operator Course, which was completed by 16 District personnel. He added that the training was conducted utilizing the District's own equipment.

10.2 EMS/Logistics - Deputy Chief Krause

EMS/Logistics Report of monthly activities.

Deputy Chief Krause provided further information about the five EMS Field Saves that took place in January. He added that one incident, involving a 12 year old child, was followed up with a debriefing for involved personnel, with Chaplain Nick Vleisides.

10.3 Fire Prevention - Fire Marshal Kiefer

Fire Prevention Report of monthly activities.

Fire Marshal Kiefer discussed Emergency Management Training and how Fire Prevention is working with other Contra Costa County agencies to identify trainings in the future that address Emergency Operations Centers and ICS. Staff has been training on website and social media procedures. Chief Meyer added that since the departure of Kim French, Fire Prevention is looking into filling the PIO, Website and Social Media void by examining efficiencies and subsequent reassignments. Fire Marshal Kiefer spoke briefly about how staff has been working with the school district to update their Emergency Plans.

10.4 Administrative Services – Financial Consultant Ken Campo

- a). Monthly Finance Activities/Reports
- b). Monthly Human Resources Activities/Reports

Financial Consultant Campo provided an overview of the Administrative Services Report for January 2015, submitted to Board Members. Highlighting that five-million dollars of new money had been raised to construct the replacement for Fire Station 32 and that staff attended meetings at CCCERA with regard to GASB 67/68 valuations, contribution rates and terminal pay to determine any impact on the District.

Controller Koran discussed the 14/15 combined General Fund Reserves stating that cash balances were in the same place as this point in time last year. He said that salaries and benefits are tracking to budget and that General Fund Expenditures are also tracking right on budget. Ambulance Revenue is not performing to budget estimates, but staff will need to analyze further for more

accurate information. He pointed out that the General Fund Revenues were better than budgeted because of a \$2.5 million increase in property tax revenues.

10.5 Fire Chief - Fire Chief Meyer

Verbal report on monthly meetings, seminars, committee meetings, and other District related activities.

Chief Meyer reported that Thomas G. McCarthy will serve, on a contract basis, as the Executive Director of the East Bay Regional Communications System Authority; EBRCSA. He said an After Action Review (ARR) was conducted with the candidate Battalion Chiefs (in an effort to evaluate the interview process). Staff prepared, as possible, for the Insurance Services Office (ISO) audit as example paperwork could not be located from the previous audit. The Request for Proposal (RFP) for the County's Ambulance Contract was approved by the State of California. He relayed that HR Consultant Harman has submitted an HR Working Draft proposal. With regard to Station 32, he discussed briefly the Facilities Subcommittee meeting and how staff continues to work with the County and the neighbors of the property. He added that one-on-one meetings are beneficial and that staff plans to go before the MAC next month to provide an update about Station 32.

11. Good of the Order

A brief discussion ensued about the Attorney General's (AG) opinion on Section "201" of the Emergency Medical Services Act. Director Dakin, the Chair of the EMS Subcommittee, requested that a subcommittee meeting be held in the near future to discuss the AG's ruling and whether or not the District would send a response letter directly to the AG. Director Parker, also on the EMS Subcommittee, concurred.

12. Closed Session

12.1 Possible exposure to litigation (one matter). [Pursuant to Government Code §54956.9(d)(2)]. Facts and circumstances that might result in litigation need not be disclosed.

14. Report Upon Return from Closed Session (if applicable)

District Counsel, William Ross, reported on matters considered in Closed Session. With respect to Agenda Item No. 12.1, possible exposure to litigation, three matters were discussed. There was reportable action with respect to two of those matters, which were Claims for Money or Damages against the District, both dated January 26, 2015. One by a Sigrid Meir, in the amount of \$820.00, for alleged damage to a retaining wall, located at 100 Oak View Terrance in the Town of Danville. The other was a Claim by the Bridges at San Ramon, through its Property Manager, Ms. Ellen McQuoid, at 309 Springfield Drive in San Ramon, in the amount of \$1,163.00 for alleged damage to carport posts by District apparatus on described property. Both matters were considered by the Board and each Claim was rejected unanimously.

With respect to the third matter considered, there was no reportable action under the common law attorney-client privileged and that provided by Government Code section 54956.9(d)(2).

There was no action taken with respect to Agenda Item No. 12.2.

Overtime and Portal to Portal Pay for Employees Assigned to Emergency Response

Background:

The San Ramon Valley Fire Protection District participates in the California Fire Service and Rescue Emergency Mutual Aid System. The California Fire Assistance Agreement (CFAA) is the negotiated reimbursement mechanism for local government fire agency responses under the Mutual Aid System. The CFAA provides for reimbursement of overtime and portal to portal to District employees while in the course of their employment and away from their official duty station and assigned to an emergency incident, in support of an emergency incident, or pre-positioned for emergency response. The District is currently reimbursed for overtime and portal to portal costs. In order to be eligible for continued reimbursement, the District must approve the attached resolution. So far in FY2014/15, the District has received \$222,000 of reimbursements through the CFAA.

Recommended Board Action:

Approve the attached resolution authorizing overtime and portal to portal pay for employees.

Financial Impacts:

Authorizing overtime and portal to portal pay for employees allows the District to continue to be eligible for reimbursement through the CFAA, amounting to potentially \$200,000 per year.

Background:

On July 25, 2012, the Board awarded a contract to LCA Architects for the architectural services related to the construction of Fire Station 32. Pursuant to the contract, LCA developed a set of design drawings. In April 2013, the Board provided direction to staff to cease further action on the project due to fiscal constraints.

As part of the 14/15 Fiscal Year Budget Goals, staff was directed to develop design modifications for Fire Station 32 to ensure the most cost effective design and ensure continuance of the approved land-use permit.

In January 2015, the Board secured funds for the construction of Fire Station 32.

Currently, District staff is prepared to move forward with design modifications and ultimate construction of Fire Station 32. In order to complete this project in the most efficient manner, staff is recommending the District amend the existing contract with LCA Architect to include the additional services needed to complete the project. Such services will include a new set of design drawings and construction specifications for the revised design. These plans will include Architectural, Structural, Mechanical, Plumbing, Electrical, Civil and Landscape revisions. The contract will also include construction administration services

Recommended Board Action:

District Staff recommends entering into this contract with LCA Architects, not to exceed \$305,000.

Approval of Resolution No. 2015-01 for the 2015 Exterior Hazard Abatement

Program

Background:

Due to the potential for wildland fires within the District, the Exterior Hazard Abatement Program is essential in the prevention and control of wildland fires. Proper abatement and installation of fuel breaks provides defensible space for emergency responders and reduces risk to life and property in the event of a wildland fire event.

Pursuant to Health and Safety Code sections 14900.5 and 14900.6, your Board by resolution may declare that (a) the nuisances arising from dry grass, weeds, dead trees and/or rubbish on the properties list on Exhibit 1 hereto are "seasonal and recurrent" and (b) such "seasonal and recurring nuisances" shall be abated every year without further hearing. Such a resolution will provide ongoing authority to the District to send the "Legal Notice" to the owner(s) of each of the properties so listed each year. Although most of the properties were included in the SRVFPD Resolution 2013-03, staff recommends that your Board adopt the attached resolution which should include any new property owners based on the current Contra Costa County Assessors Office records.

Program Modifications due to Drought

In an effort to create awareness around wildfire and the additional risks that may be present due to current drought conditions the following modifications are proposed:

- 1. Postcard sent via direct mail to all property owners in the exterior hazard abatement program. Projected mail date of April 1, 2015. (See attached Post Card)
- Standard mail out of Legal notice to all new property owners and non-compliant properties from the 2014 abatement season. Projected mail date of April 1, 2015 (See attached Legal Notice)

- 3. Media Release disseminated to local news outlets to correspond with the April postcard mail out.
- 4. Continued Drought/wildfire messaging on firedepartment.org and partnering cities/towns websites.
- 5. Continued social media messaging on District sponsored Facebook, Twitter and PulsePoint platforms.
- 6. Utilize temporary signage in wildland areas to remind residents of the May 31 deadline.
- 7. Initial inspections to remain the first two weeks in June.

As always the Fire District will make every effort to work with property owners to gain compliance. Historically, nearly all property owners complete the necessary clearance themselves; however, for those who do not clear their property as required, the District has contracted with a hazard abatement contractor who will perform the work on behalf of the District.

The cost of the contracted work, plus an administrative fee, will then be placed on the property owner's tax bill as a tax lien. Continued communication with property owners by the District should maintain the trend of clearing fewer properties while preserving the level of risk reduction set forth by the District.

Recommended Board Action:

It is recommended that pursuant to the Health and Safety Code sections 14900.5 and 14900.6, your Board deem, by approving Resolution No. 2015-01, that the properties listed on Exhibit 1 may have seasonal and recurrent weeds that, unless abated, will each year constitute a fire hazard. The properties listed on Exhibit 1 are part of the District's Exterior Hazard Abatement Program. All properties, in the program, are in a wildfire hazard severity zone as identified by the California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection and/or designated in accordance with the District Fire Code.

The properties listed on Exhibit 1 have been posted on the District website and a copy has been made available for public examination at the Administrative Office. In compliance with the Health and Safety Code, a legal notice will be published in the San Ramon Valley Times and will invite property owners to appear in person before your Board on May 27, 2015 to show just cause why their property should not be part of the program.

WHEREAS, these properties, as determined by the Fire District, through its knowledge and inspection of these properties during the life of the Exterior Hazard Abatement Program, are subject to seasonal and recurrent dry grass, weeds, and/or rubbish constituting nuisances; and

WHEREAS, as part of an Exterior Hazard Abatement Program, Health and Safety Code sections 14900.5 and 14900.6 authorize the Board to declare that (a) the nuisances arising from dry grass, weeds, dead trees and/or rubbish on such properties are "seasonal and recurrent" and (b) such "seasonal and recurring nuisances" shall be abated every year without further hearing; and

WHEREAS, in the case of dry grass, weeds, dead trees and/or rubbish which have been so declared to constitute seasonal and recurring nuisances, the Health and Safety Code sections further provide that it is sufficient for the Fire District to annually mail notices to the property owners as they and their addresses appear upon the current assessment roll advising them to abate said nuisances without particularized findings by this Board each year that such nuisances presently exist; and

WHEREAS, such a declaration by this Board will enhance the efficiency and effectiveness of the Fire District's Exterior Hazard Abatement Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows:

- 1. The Board hereby finds and declares that nuisances arising from dry grass, weeds, dead trees and/or rubbish on the properties listed on Exhibit 1 to this resolution are "seasonal and recurrent" as that term is used in Health and Safety Code section 14900.5.
- 2. The Board hereby further finds and declares that such seasonal and recurring nuisances shall be abated every year without further hearing

Dear Property Owner,

With record low rainfall and a wildfire season that is already upon us, San Ramon Valley Firefighters are asking property owners to prepare early. Taking some simple steps now can greatly reduce your risk of property loss in the event of a wildfire.

- 1. Create 100 feet of defensible space around your home. This area is the space firefighters need to get between your home and the oncoming fire. Make sure this space is well maintained or landscaped. Take action to cut native grasses to less than three inches and limb up trees five feet from the ground. Remove other combustibles around your home such as dry pine needles. Some homes may also require a fuel break around the perimeter of the property.
- 2. Make a date with your roof! Your roof is the most vulnerable part of your home; ensure your roof and gutters are clear of pine needles, leaves and other debris. If you have a shake roof, consider replacing it with a non-combustible roof made to withstand heat and embers.
- 3. Confirm the numbers on your house are clearly visible and that your driveway or private road is maintained so emergency vehicles can access your home quickly.
- 4. Use trimming, mowing and powered equipment before 10 a.m. on days that are <u>not</u> hot or windy. Be aware of Red Flag Warning days.

Please accept our appreciation for your efforts in providing a greater degree of fire safety within our community.

YOU ARE HEREBY FURTHER NOTIFIED that the San Ramon Valley Fire Protection District's Board of Directors has declared that all dry grass, weeds, dead trees and/or rubbish constitutes a seasonal and recurring public nuisance. Any property(s) that is found to be non-compliant after the May 31 deadline will be subject to the Administrative Citation Process and can be issued a citation and fine of up to \$2,000. Additionally, if the District must abate your property(s) because you fail to do so, an administrative fee not to exceed \$1,200 in addition to the cost of the abatement work will be assessed in the form of a lien on your property.

YOU MAY APPEAR in person before the Board of Directors on May 27, 2015, to show just cause why this order should not be enforced.

If this property(s) is being leased or used by someone other than the owner, it is the owner's responsibility to contact the lessee or user and arrange for any necessary abatement.

Goal 1

Distribution of Fire Stations for Built-up Urban Areas of Greater than 2,000 People per Square Mile

To treat and transport medical patients and control small fires, the first-due unit should arrive within 7 minutes total response time, 90 percent of the time from the receipt of the call in fire dispatch. Total response time equates to 1 minute dispatch time, 2 minute crew turnout time and 4 minutes travel time spacing for single units.

Goal 2

Distribution of Fire Stations for Suburban Areas of 1,000 to 2,000 People per Square Mile The first-due fire unit should arrive within 8 minutes total response time, 90 percent of the time.

Goal 3

Distribution of Fire Stations for Rural Areas of Less than 1,000 People per Square Mile The first-due fire unit should arrive within 15 minutes total response time, 90 percent of the time.

Goal 4

Effective Response Force (First Alarm) for Urban Areas of Greater than 2,000 People per Square Mile

To confine fires near the room of origin, to stop wildfires less than 5 acres in size when noticed promptly, and to treat up to 5 medical patients at once, a multiple-unit response of at least 18 personnel should arrive within 11 minutes total response time from the time of 911 call receipt, 90 percent of the time. This equates to 1 minute dispatch time, 2 minutes crew turnout time and 8 minutes travel time spacing for multiple units. Suburban areas should receive the full first alarm within 12 minutes total response time, 90 percent of the time with the goal to limit the fire spread to the area already involved upon the arrival of the effective response force. For rural areas, this should be 21 minutes, 90 percent of the time. Outcome goals in these areas would be to confine fires to the building of origin, to care for medical patients upon arrival, and to initiate operations on serious wildland fires.

Goal 5

Hazardous Materials Response

Respond to hazardous materials emergencies with enough trained personnel to protect the community from the hazards associated with the release of hazardous and toxic materials. Achieve a total response time consistent with Goal 1, Goal 2 and Goal 3 with the first company capable of operating at the California OSHA First Responder Operations (FRO) level. After size-up and scene evaluation is complete a determination will be made whether to request the on-duty District Hazardous Materials Team and/or other appropriate resources.

Goal 6

Technical Rescue

Respond to technical rescue emergencies with enough trained personnel to facilitate a successful rescue. Achieve a total response time consistent with Goal 1, Goal 2 and Goal 3 with the first company capable of operating at the California Rescue System 1 (RS1) level. After size-up and scene evaluation is complete a determination will be made whether to request the on-duty District Rescue Team and/or other appropriate resources.

Goal 7

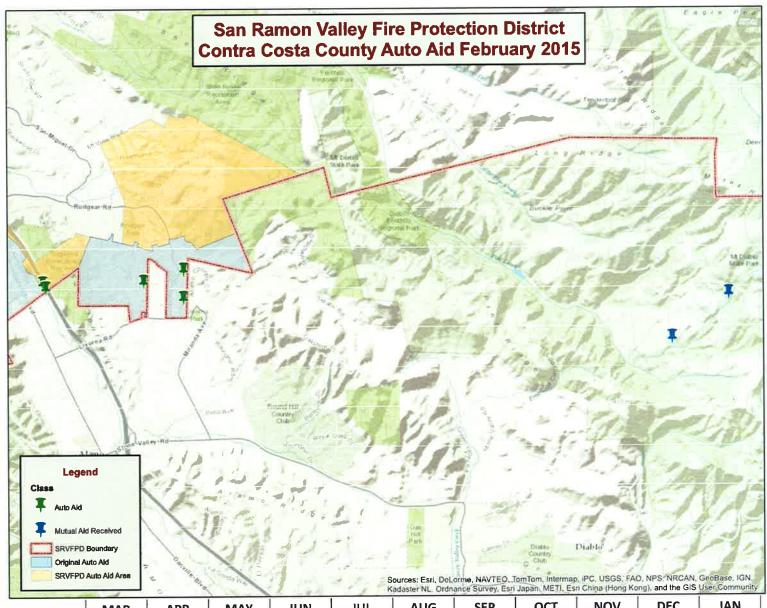
Call processing and turnout times

A concentrated focus will be placed on systems, training and feedback measures to crews to lower dispatch and turnout time reflex measures to national best practices of 1 minute for dispatch and 2 minutes for fire crew turnout, 90 percent of the time.

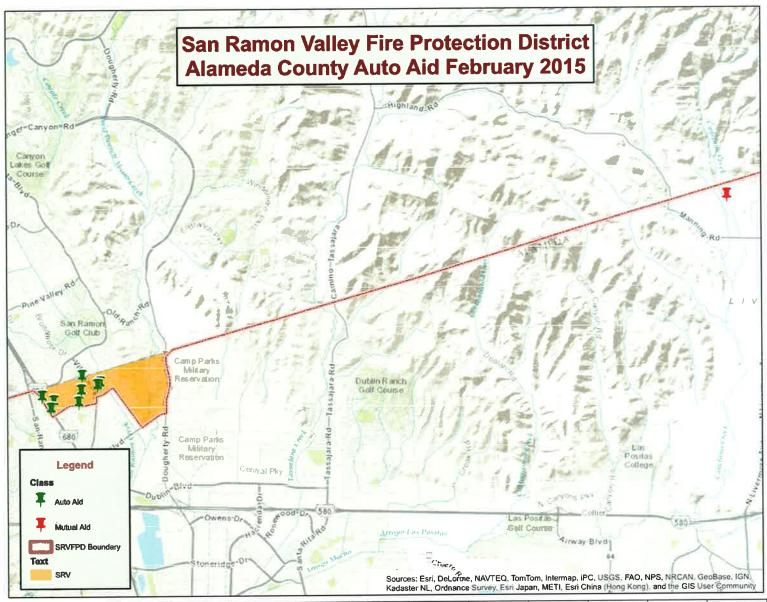
Goal 8

Effective Response Force for Advanced Life Support (ALS) Medical Emergencies

To treat medical patients requiring advanced procedures and skills (defined as Charlie, Delta or Echo), a two-unit response consisting of one paramedic-staffed ambulance and one additional paramedic-staffed unit for a response force of at least five personnel should arrive within 6 minutes travel time in urban areas and 7 minutes travel time in suburban areas, 90 percent of the time. For rural areas, excluding Mt. Diablo State Park, personnel should arrive within 18 minutes travel time 90 percent of the time.

Fire Prevention Activity Reports

Attached are the Fire Prevention Activity Reports for the month of February.

Preparation for ISO

Staff provided the ISO representative the completed Community Risk Reduction Form and supporting documentation to address criteria that included code compliance, fire investigation. pre-plan and public education activities. As part of the process, ISO staff advised that there were 742 buildings within the Fire District boundaries that are identified as non-sprinklered. The ISO representative advised that we verify whether or not the data was correct and if some of the buildings are sprinklered then advise the building owner to notify there insurance carrier. As a result, if the insurance carrier reports correctly there should be corrections made to the ISO database to reflect the fire protection and the building owner should be awarded with a reduced insurance rate.

Code Compliance Officer Rian Evitt took on the task of taking lead in the development and completion of the project. Currently the work is projected to be completed by the end of March.

Residential Care Facility Workshop

On May 12, the 6th Annual Residential Care Facility Fire and Life Safety Workshop will be held at the Creekside Community Church in Alamo from 1pm - 4pm. The workshop will include an "Ask the Experts" panel. The panel will include the; Regional Manager for Community Care Licensing, Director of the Contra Costa County Ombudsman Program, San Ramon Valley Fire EMS Captain, Nurse Educator of the Hospice of the East Bay, City of San Ramon Crime Prevention Specialist. Other program highlights will include three 30-minute breakout sessions;

- 1. Stroke Recognition and How to Properly fill out the POLST Form.
- 2. Fire Extinguisher Training
- 3. How to Conduct a Comprehensive and Safe Evacuation Drill

As in the past, CEU will be provided to administrators and caregivers in attendance. County Health Services has recently joined the RCF Workgroup and will be working toward expanding similar programs throughout the Contra Costa County.

Grad Night Training

February 24, Code Compliance Officer Evitt held the Grad Night Annual Training for the eight schools that hold this student event. The training is held for Parent Liaison's and School Representatives to review and update event coordinators with current fire and life safety rules and regulations. This effort is a pre-planning educational opportunity to ensure student activities, facility decorations and other safety concerns are understood prior to the event and fire inspection. A survey was completed by attendees and results are attached.

San Ramon Rotary, Sunny Glen Event

On Saturday, April 25 the San Ramon Rotary Club and Fire District will team up to change the smoke alarm and carbon monoxide batteries in homes in the Sunny Glen community. They are also offering to replace smoke alarms that are more than 10 years old and are offering to install carbon monoxide detectors in homes without one. Joyce Castro is working with Rotary Club representatives on pre-event planning, coordinating registered signups and correct placement of devices.

Update on San Ramon Valley Emergency Preparedness Citizen Corps Council (SRVEPCCC)-School Disaster Preparedness Project

As part of the 2015 project, staff members will be visiting all 38 SRVUSD school sites and meeting with Principals to evaluate and address the following;

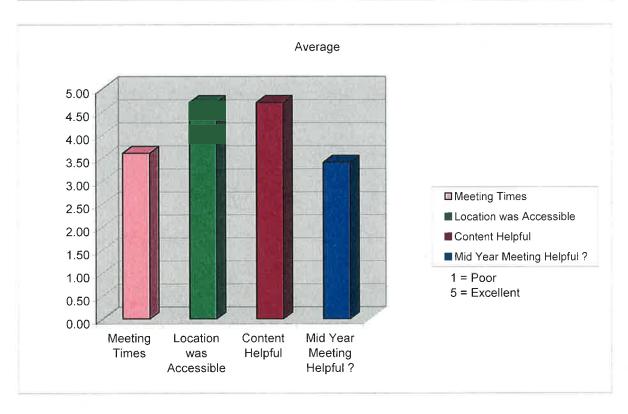
- Do they have a current Emergency Plan and know where it is? If they have one are they familiar with it and do they exercise it?
- Where are the current evacuation routes and do they feel it works.
- Do they have emergency backpacks in each class? If yes, do they have a current class list and what contents are in the bag.
- Upon evacuation do they use the red and green signs to show they have all their kids.
- Walk the school to talk about what's working and any issues/questions they may have
- PD talks about intruder on campus and answers question related to lock downs, etc.
- Visit the Disaster Supply kit and review inventory
- Advise they will be receiving updated Pre-Incident Survey Maps.
- Review challenges for each site.
- Advise future training will be coordinated to assist in addressing their specific needs and questions.

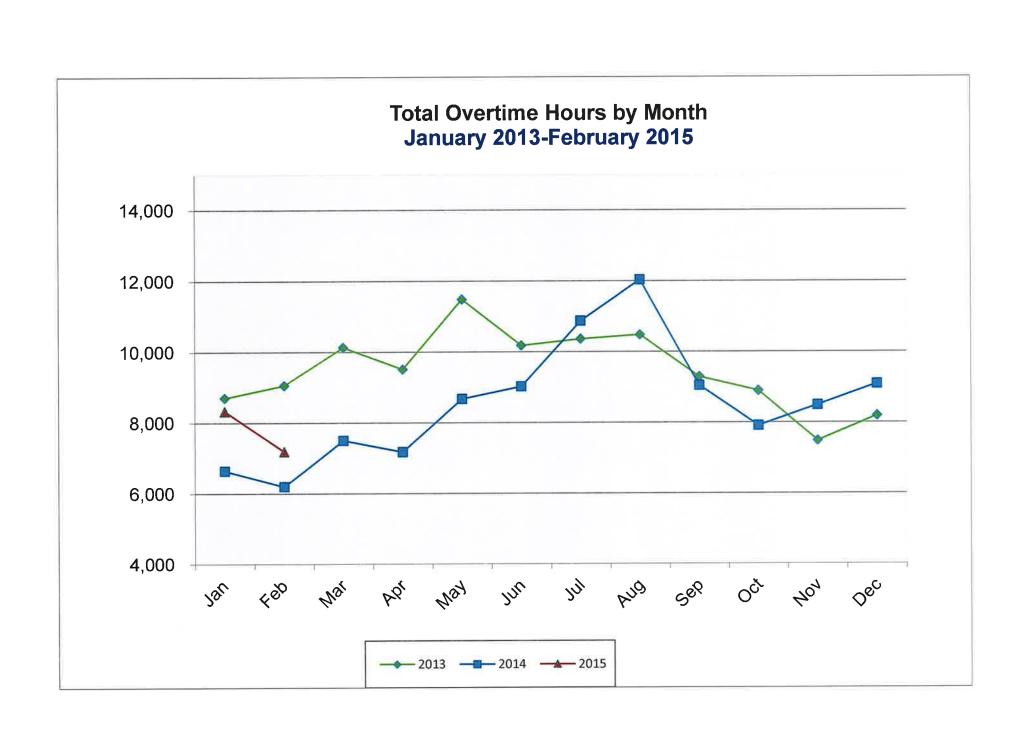
